## WANTED MVSRC Summer 2010 Lifeguards

Interested in becoming a lifeguard? Being a lifeguard requires focus, a sharp eye and excellent swimming skills. Prerequisites include; minimum age 15, swim 300 yards continuously. Also, starting in the water, swim 20 yards using front crawl (freestyle) or breast stroke, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10 pound object, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object and exit the water without using a ladder or steps, within 1 minute, 40 seconds. If you have read to this point and you are still interested in becoming a lifeguard, contact Sue Ward, Club Manager for a scheduled appointment. Lifeguard training is completed by attending one of the American Red Cross Training programs; Montanoso, Laguna Niguel and Irvine area. Call the office at 949-837-4070 or stop by the club office after school for an employment application and schedule of Lifeguard training classes.
